

LCBI High School Student Bursary

PURPOSE: The purpose of the LCBI Student Bursary is to give assistance to students who are members of this congregation, and are or will be attending the Lutheran Collegiate Bible Institute (LCBI). The bursary signifies the congregation's commitment to equipping the saints for work in His service.

FUND INCOME: Funds are raised through congregational appeals and designated offerings through the envelope system.

ELIGIBILITY: Prospective high school students who are members of this congregation may apply for a congregational grant to attend LCBI.

EXTENT OF THE CONGREGATIONAL BURSARY: At the discretion of the congregation, eligible students will receive bursaries to the extent that funds are made available.

Special Note: Students who are awarded a congregational bursary are also eligible for a matched bursary from LCBI. The matched bursary shall not exceed \$200 for residential students or \$100 for day students. Congregations may provide bursaries for a larger amount than that which is matched.

The LCBI High School Student Matching Bursary application must be received at LCBI by June 1 of each year. The congregational bursary funds are due by August 15.

LCBI High School Student Matching Bursary

PURPOSE:

- to assist ELCIC students to attend the Lutheran Collegiate Bible Institute High School
- to create greater awareness of LCBI High School among congregations
- to encourage congregational involvement by providing matching bursaries to members who apply to attend LCBI High School

ELIGIBILITY:

- all students who have been awarded an ELCIC Congregational Student Bursary will receive a matching grant from LCBI High School. Matching bursaries are up to \$100 for day students and up to \$200 for residential students.

DURATION:

- these awards are given on an annual basis, application for which must be made by **June 1** of each year
- students must apply to their congregations and complete the application process early enough to meet this deadline

PRESENTATION:

- congregations are encouraged to make a formal presentation of the LCBI High School Student Matching Bursary to the recipient(s) at a congregational gathering such as a worship service or family night.
